NJSBA's School Leader Award spotlights creative public school programs that are proven to enhance learning.

*Winners of the School Leader Award will be honored at NJSBA's Annual Workshop in October. Programs also will be featured in *School Leader* magazine.

Programs will be judged on:

- Degree of innovation and challenge.
- How well the program addresses a need.
- How the program integrates into the school district's curriculum and the state's Core Curriculum Content Standards.
- Evaluation strategies.
- Community involvement, if applicable.
- Future plans for improvement.

To be eligible, the program must have been in effect for at least two years.

Each program entry should include:

- Name and title of person responsible for program.
- Concise goal statement.
- Description of program, no longer than 700 words, including the following information:
 - Number of students served.
 - How long program has been in effect.
 - How program is funded.
 - Information/statistics illustrating the results of program.
- List of the specific Core Curriculum Content Standards that the program addresses and how it does so.
- Photos showcasing program in action. (Photos must be of reproducible quality and available in digital format.)
- Supplemental materials, if available, such as brochures, flyers, letters, announcements, CDs, DVDs, or diskettes (no video or audiotapes).
