WHEREAS, New Jersey's public schools serve nearly 1.4 million children in prekindergarten through 12th grade; and

WHEREAS, New Jersey's 4,800 local board of education members devote countless hours, without remuneration, to the oversight of school district operations, including finances, policy, curriculum and staffing; and

WHEREAS, as the policymaking bodies for local school districts, New Jersey's local boards of education endeavor to meet the challenges facing public schools and to help students attain the education necessary to excel in college and in the workplace and to enable them to compete in a global economy; and

WHEREAS, local boards of education have contributed to New Jersey being among the leading states in measures of academic quality such as National Assessment of Educational Progress scores, and the preparation for college through advanced placement offerings and SAT assessments; and

WHEREAS, the National School Boards Association and the New Jersey School Boards Association have declared January 2015 to be School Board Recognition Month; and

WHEREAS, by making meaningful contributions to public education, the dedicated members of local school boards have greatly enhanced the quality of life in our State;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CHRIS CHRISTIE, Governor of the State of New Jersey, do hereby proclaim:
