

GOVERNANCE PROCEDURES
AFFILIATE MEMBERS

Affiliate Members

In accordance with NJSBA Bylaws (Article III, Section 3) the Board of Directors hereby establishes the following rights, privileges and responsibilities of affiliate members.

Governance

The governing body of each affiliate member shall have the right to send a representative to the Delegate Assemblies of the Association.

Affiliate members shall not have the right to speak to or vote on the issues and questions before the Delegate Assemblies and shall be subject to the "Rules of Conduct for the Delegate Assembly Meeting."

Affiliate members may submit resolutions for consideration of the Delegate Assembly to the Board of Directors, which will then determine if it is to be presented as a resolution to the Delegate Assembly.

Services

Attendance at all workshops, programs and inservice activities of the Association shall be available to affiliate members under the same conditions as regular members, except that for meetings with enrollment limits preference shall be given to regular members.

Affiliate members shall, upon identification of appropriate board members and staff, be included in the mailing of official publications and other communication. The Executive Director is authorized to determine appropriate mailings and their recipients.

Affiliate members shall be eligible to receive any other services and assistance normally provided to regular members upon the approval of the Executive Director.

Dues and Fees

The Executive Director is authorized to establish and periodically review administrative regulations governing the fees to be charged to affiliate members.

Any fees charged for extraordinary or special services shall be at the same rate as for district boards of education.
