Criteria for Admitting Emergency Resolutions

In order to be admitted as an emergency resolution to a Delegate Assembly, the resolution must have been submitted by a board in good standing and meet all three of the following criteria:

- A. Substantial harm to the district or students could result from omission or commission if the resolution is not considered by the delegates.
- B. The issue did not surface sufficiently in advance of the Delegate Assembly to enable the sponsoring board to submit the resolution in a timely fashion.
- C. There is potential for action on legislation, code, or other regulation before the next succeeding Delegate Assembly.
