Periodic Review of Bylaws

The Association's Bylaws are the framework for NJSBA's organizational operations. In order to ensure that the bylaws provide for consistent, efficient and orderly operations, they should be reviewed on a regular basis.

The Executive Director shall establish procedures to ensure that the bylaws are reviewed on a regular basis to determine their continued relevancy to the Association's needs.

The object of the bylaws review procedure is to promote an orderly and democratic process for delegate action and to allow time for proper research prior to delegate action so that the delegates shall have available as much information as possible to aid them in their decisions.

Readoption of the bylaws in current form or with amendments shall be proposed to the Delegate Assembly once every three years beginning at the November/December 2000 Delegate Assembly.
