Periodic Review of Positions and Policies on Education

The Association's positions and policies on education are the framework for NJSBA activities and efforts in legislative, legal, program and service areas. In order to ensure that these positions and policies address the current priorities of public education and the needs of New Jersey's school districts, there is a need for them to be reviewed on a regular basis.

The Executive Director shall establish procedures to ensure that all positions and policies on education are reviewed on a regular basis to determine their relevancy to current education needs.

Reaffirmation, or reaffirmation with changes or deletions of the statements in the Association's Manual of Positions and Policies on Education shall be proposed periodically to the Delegate Assembly in a continuous process of review, so that every such statement shall be reviewed not less than once every five years.
