RESOLUTIONS

Source of Resolutions and Bylaw Amendments

Resolutions and bylaw amendments may be submitted to the Resolutions Subcommittee for forwarding to the delegates for action at any regular or special meeting of the delegates by:

- A. Any local board of education in New Jersey that is a member in good standing of the Association. Such resolution and bylaw amendment must be adopted by a majority vote of such board of education at the regular or special meeting prior to its submission to the Association;
- B. Any county school boards association. Such resolution and bylaw amendment must be adopted by a majority vote of the membership or executive committee of such county association at the regular or special meeting prior to its submission to the Association;
- C. The Board of Directors of the New Jersey School Boards Association. Such resolution and bylaw amendment must be adopted by a majority vote of that board at the regular or special meeting prior to its submission to the Association;
- D. Any committee of the New Jersey School Boards Association. Such resolution and bylaw amendment must be germane to the committee's charge and must be adopted by a majority vote of such committee at the regular or special meeting prior to its submission to the Association; and
- E. The Executive Committee of the New Jersey School Boards Association may submit an emergency resolution pursuant to Section 7c of this article. Such resolution must be adopted by a majority vote of such committee at the regular or special meeting prior to its submission to the Association.
