State Graduation Requirements and Remedial Programs

The NJSBA believes boards of education should provide remediation or special attention to all students who fail to meet local and/or state high school graduation requirements and proficiency standards. Remediation should begin as early as possible. The State should assume its fair share of the cost of these remedial programs. *[Authority: DA 10/78-CR (Graduation Requirements), DA 11/97-SR, DA 11/02-SR, DA 11/07-SR, DA 11/12-SR, DA 11/17-SR, DA 11/22-SR]*

After School Busing for Remedial Instruction

The NJSBA believes that the state should provide transportation aid for reimbursement of after-school busing services for remedial instruction. The State should provide transportation funding for all students of all abilities in order to more fully participate in district after school programs. *[Authority: DA 12/86-2, DA 12/90-12, DA 11/97-SR, DA 11/02-SR, DA 11/07-SR, DA 11/12-SR, DA 5/14 (Special Education Task Force), DA 11/17-SR, DA 11/22-SR]*
