## State Graduation Requirements and Remedial Programs

**The NJSBA believes** boards of education should provide remediation or special attention to all students who fail to meet local and/or state high school graduation requirements and proficiency standards. Remediation should begin as early as possible. The State should assume its fair share of the cost of these remedial programs. ## After School Busing for Remedial Instruction

**The NJSBA believes** that the state should provide transportation aid for reimbursement of after-school busing services for remedial instruction. The State should provide transportation funding for all students of all abilities in order to more fully participate in district after school programs.
