

## **First Notice: Delegate Assembly Resolution Deadline**

Resolutions stating proposed policy positions may be submitted by local boards of education, county school boards associations, the New Jersey School Boards Association's Board of Directors and standing committees for consideration at the NJSBA's meeting of delegates on Saturday, November 19.

Policy adopted by the Delegate Assembly is included in NJSBA's Manual of Positions and Policies on Education. That policy determines NJSBA's advocacy positions in Trenton, Washington, D.C., and the courts.

Resolutions for the November 19 meeting must be received at NJSBA's office by 5 p.m. Thursday, September 15. Notice regarding the cutoff date was emailed to school business administrators, county association presidents, board presidents and board delegates on June 16, 2022.

That notice included the Delegate Assembly resolution format and the NJSBA resolution dates.
