WHEREAS, more than 232,599 children receive special education instruction and services in New Jersey's public and private schools; and

WHEREAS, more than 14,715 children who receive special education instruction and services are enrolled in preschool and early intervention programs in New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, many parents, teachers, child study team members and school administrators generously give their time and energy to support the learning needs of students who receive special education; and

WHEREAS, since 1985, the New Jersey School Boards Association and ASAHI have sponsored Special Education Week in New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the theme for Special Education Week 2023 is "Creating a Better World;" and

WHEREAS, the public-school districts and the private schools of New Jersey make a major contribution to the public welfare by preparing thousands of exceptional persons to participate as citizens of this state and as members of society;
