## ACCESS for ELLs

## ACCESS for ELLs

- The ACCESS for ELLs assessments serve as New Jersey's English Language Proficiency (ELP) assessments as required by ESSA and N.J.A.C. 6A:15-1.10(b).
- ACCESS for ELLs is administered in grades $\mathrm{K}-12$ to students who have been identified as English Learners (ELs).
- ELs are students whose native language is other than English and have varying degrees of ELP in any one of the language domains of speaking, reading, writing, or listening.
- ACCESS for ELLs measures English proficiency growth tied to the WIDA (WorldClass Instructional Design and Assessment) English Language Proficiency standards, which are aligned to the academic content area standards.
- An Overall Composite cut score of 4.5 (on a scale from 1.0 to 6.0 ) on the ACCESS for ELLs assessment is used as one of multiple measures by which EL students are exited from program services in NJ.

## NJGPA Overview

- NJGPA is designed to measure the extent to which students are graduation ready in English Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics.
- Graduation readiness is reported separately for each content component.
- The ELA component is aligned to the grade 10 standards.
- The Mathematics component is aligned to Algebra I and Geometry standards.

- Educators are credited with providing their students with social, emotional, and academic supports during a historically challenging time in recovery from the COVID-19 public health emergency.
- With the implementation of the NJPSS, it is anticipated that performance will continue to increase.
