

**GOVERNANCE PROCEDURES
ASSOCIATE MEMBERS**

Associate Members

In accordance with NJSBA bylaws (Article III, Section 4) the Board of Directors hereby establishes the following rights, privileges and responsibilities of Associate Members.

Common Interest Group Associate Membership

Individuals throughout the state that share common interests and responsibilities related to the needs and operations of local school districts may be invited to join common interest organizations sponsored by NJSBA. Groups such as the Associate Membership Program for School Attorneys (AMPASA), the Educational Negotiators Association (ENA) and the Personnel Administrators Association (PAA) are included in this category of membership.

The Executive Director is authorized to establish and periodically review administrative regulations governing the fees to be charged to members of these groups and the services and privileges they will receive.

The establishment of all Common Interest Group Associate Membership Programs shall require approval of the Board of Directors.

Associate Membership through a Common Interest Group does not provide any rights and privileges in the governance of the Association.

Individual Associate Membership

Any individual whose work or interests address the concerns, activities and services of the NJSBA, and who is not eligible for membership in any other category of membership in the Association, may become an Associate Member of NJSBA.

Associate Members shall not have any rights and privileges in the governance of the Association.

Annual membership dues for Associate Members shall coincide with the fiscal year of the Association.

Associate Members shall receive mailings of publications and those special mailings that the Executive Director determines to be appropriate.

The Executive Director is directed to periodically review the dues and privileges accorded Associate Members and to bring recommendation for changes to the attention of the Board of Directors.
