GOVERNANCE PROCEDURES RESOLUTION PROCEDURES

Criteria for Admitting Emergency Resolutions

In order to be admitted as an emergency resolution to a Delegate Assembly, the resolution must have been submitted by a board in good standing and meet all three of the following criteria:

A. Substantial harm to the district or students could result from omission or commission if the resolution is not considered by the delegates.

B. The issue did not surface sufficiently in advance of the Delegate Assembly to enable the sponsoring board to submit the resolution in a timely fashion.

C. There is potential for action on legislation, code, or other regulation before the next succeeding Delegate Assembly.
