

BYLAWS

OFFICERS: QUALIFICATIONS AND ELECTION

Election of Officers

The election of the president and three vice presidents of the Association shall be held at the annual meeting in odd-numbered years. Special elections shall be held as set forth in Article VII, Section 8 when necessary to select a successor to complete the term of an officer who ceased to be a member of a district board of education, or who resigned his officer position, or who was removed by the Board of Directors pursuant to Article VII, Section 2c. The procedures set forth below shall be followed in conducting all elections:

- A. In case there shall be more than one candidate for any elected office, voting for such office shall be by secret ballot and the candidate receiving a majority vote of those voting shall be declared elected. In the event no candidate receives a majority vote, then there shall be a run-off election by secret ballot between the candidates receiving the two highest number of votes; and
- B. No person shall be nominated for more than one office during any election of officers.
